reply residence beyond the seas, coverture or imprisonment, to a plea of limitation.

January next, the Plaintiff or Plaintiffs in any action or suit thereafter to be brought, shall not be permitted to reply his or their residence beyond the seas, or beyond the jurisdiction of the Courts of Canada, coverture or 5 imprisonment, to any plea of the said Act, or of any other Statute of Limitations, and he, she, and they shall be as effectually barred, and the said Statute and every other Statute of Limitations shall run against him, 10 her or them, during the time of his, her, or their residence beyond the seas, or beyond the jurisdiction of the Courts in Canada, and during her coverture, or his, her, or their imprisonment, in the same manner and with 15 the like effect as if he, she, or they had been resident within the Province during such period, discovert or at large, anything in the said Proviso to the said Statute, or in any other law to the contrary thereof notwith- 20 standing.
