An Act to amend the Act respecting the assessment of property in Upper Canada.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Preamble. Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 1. Unpatented land, vested in or held by Her Majesty, but which Unpatented has been, or shall be, sold or agreed to be sold to any person, or which lands located 5 has been or shall be located upon as a free grant, shall be held to be to taxation have been liable to taxation since the first day of January now last, tion. and shall be liable to taxation thenceforward under the Act respecting the assessment of property in Upper Canada, in the same way as other land, whether any license of occupation, location ticket, certificate of 10 sale, or receipt for money paid on such sale has, or has not been, or shall, or shall not be issued, and (in the case of sale or agreement of sale) whether any payment has, or has not been, or shall or shall not be made thereon, and whether any part of the purchase money is, or is not overdue and unpaid; but such taxation shall not in any way affect Saving rights of the rights of Her Majesty in respect of such land.
 - 2. The one hundred and thirty-eighth section of the Act respecting Sect. 138 of the assessment of property in Upper Canada, shall apply to all sales cap. 55, Conand conveyances which may be hereafter made under the authority of Stat. U. O. to the said Act.
