Courts of King's Bench were by Law authorized and empowered, directed and required then and there to proceed before the passing of this Act, and in each and every such term or session of the said Court of King's Bench hereby constituted, shall have, hold and exercise the like and the same jurisdiction, powers and authorities in every respect, as the Justices of the said then existing Courts of King's Bench respectively, or any two or more of them in the said above-mentioned sessions of the said then existing Courts of King's Bench respectively, by Law had, held and exercised, before the passing of this Act.

. XXVIII. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the said Court of King's Bench hereby constituted, and the Justices thereof shall have, hold and exercise an appellate jurisdiction, and full power and authority to take cognizance of, and hear, try and determine in due course of Law, all causes, matters and things appealed or to be appealed, or removed or to be removed by Writ of Error from all, each and every Court of Civil Jurisdiction within this Province, wherein an Appeal or Revision in Error is, or hereafter may by Law be allowed; and to this end, the said Court of King's Bench hereby constituted, and the Justices thereof, severally and respectively, shall be and they are hereby vested without any diminution whatever, and as well in term as in vacation, with all, each and every the powers and authorities which, at the passing of this Act, were by Law vested in the said Court of Appeals, or in the Justices thereof, or in any or either of them, in term or in vacation.

XXIX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the Chief Justice of the Province being present in the said Court of King's Bench hereby constituted, in any of the terms or sessions thereof, shall preside therein, and in the absence of the said Chief Justice, the senior Puisné or associate Justice of the said Court of King's Bench hereby constituted, in like manner being present, shall, for the time being, preside therein, and all writs and process to be issued from and out of the said Court of King's Bench hereby constituted, shall be tested in the name of the Chief Justice of the Province, if the office of the Chief Justice of the Province shall not be vacant; and during any vacancy of the office of the Chief Justice of the Province, such writs and process shall be tested in the name of the then senior Puisne or associate Justice of the said Court of King's Bench hereby constituted.

XXX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the four Justices of the said Court of King's Bench, hereby constituted, and not less than three of them, shall sit and hold Terms or Sessions of the said Court of
