Preamble.

TheREAS great Quantities of Paper Bills of Credit have been created and issued His Wajedy's Colonies oz Plantations in America, by virtue of Ads. Divers. Resolutions. of Actes of Accembly, making and declaring such Bills

a Credit to be legal Tender in Payments of Woney: And whereas such Bills Credit have greatly depreciated in their Calue, Means whereof Debts have been discharged with a much less Ualue than was contraded for, great Discouragement and Prejudice of the Trade and Commerce of His Bajedy's Subjects, by occasioning Confusion in Dealings, and lessening Credit in the faid Colonies or Plantations: For Remedy whereof, May it please your most Excellent Majesty, that it may be enaded; and be it enaded by the King's most Excellent Wajesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lozds Spiritual and Tempotal, and Commons, in this present Parliament afsembled, and by the Authority of the same, That from and after the first Day of September, Dne thousand seven hundled and sixty sour, no Ad, Deder, Refolution, or Aote of Assembly, in any of his Hajefty's Colonies or Plantations in America, thall be made, for creating or illuing any Paper Bills, or Bills of Credit of any Kind of Denomination whatsoever, declaring such Paper Bills, of Bills of Tredit, to be legal Tender in Payment of any Barnains, Contracts, Debts, Dues, og Demands whatfoever; and every Claufe of Provision which thall hereafter be inserted in any At, Dider, Resolution, or Uote of Adembly, contrary to this Ad, thall be null and boid. 8
