up money has formed no part of our life labor. It is just and right to state this, that all whom the Lord may move to send us aid, may know that their offerings are needed, and will be thankfully received. As for myself, I am now old, nearly seventy. My work is nearly done. But now that I am old and grayheaded, my belief is that I shall not be forsaken. T can commit all into the Lord's blessed hands. He can accomplish His own work in His own way. Let us sing the 23rd Psalm, and allow the Lord Jehovah to plan His own business and to plan ours.
