Deans seek improvement

dean's office and consider the establishment of a new rank of administrative officer."

The deans suggested changing the travel budget, which they said was now incorporated "within the poverty of the general faculty budget" and was not satisfactory. Therefore, they said, there should be a "sizeable fund increase added to the budget of the dean's office to make possible the journeys necessary to enhance the reputation of UNB in other academic centres."

For travel expenses, the deans recommended adding \$1000 to each dean's office for his or her personal use, with another \$500 for each

associate and assistant dean.

In addition, the memo suggests that deans re-entering the general faculty be allowed to maintain their salaries as deans, with cost of living allowances, and with an additional stipend, or sum of money.

The Brunswickan contacted three sources to check the authenticity of the memo, and to find out which of the suggestions had, in fact, been implemented. University Secretary James Woodfield referred the paper to Deans Ker or Veitch. The paper then phoned Ker, who referred the paper to Dean Veitch.

In fact, Veitch pointed out in an interview, many of the proposals in the memo had not even reached the board of governors. Of those sent to

the president some were refused, one was put off for further study, and only one proposal, that of raising stipends, got the board's approval.

The board agreed to increase the deans' stipends from \$3300 to \$6,400 a year, and the assistant dean's stipend to \$4000 from \$2250.

The request for more money for student research staff is not, as asked, in the dean's budget. Instead a dean must request it in an application to the president.

The request for another administrative position may be "looked into later," Veitch said.
