The Rockefeller Foundation of New York has appointed Hon. Mackenzie King, Minister of Labour for Canada in the Laurier Administration, Director of a world-wide investigation into Industrial Relations with a view of furthering industrial peace and promoting better relations between Labour and Capital. No limit is set to either the time or the scope of the inquiry which will extend over many years, and will embrace a study by experts of the world's experience in industrial Reform. The Foundation is endowed with upwards of one hundred million dollars. In the Capital here, where Mr. King resides, it is considered a compliment to the British Empire, that a Canadian should have been chosen to have the Direction of this vast undertaking. Mr. King is the author of the Canadian Industrial Disputes Investigation Act and the Canadian Combines Investigation Act both of which have attracted much attention in other countries.
