

THE UNEMPLOYMENT RELIEF & ASSISTANCE ACT, 1936
DOMINION-BRITISH COLUMBIA SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT
SCHEDULE "A"

Section 1

The cost of the following stock, equipment, services etc., will be contributed to by the Dominion when necessarily supplied or done pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph 1 of the attached agreement:-

- Work stock, including horses, mules and oxen;
- Other farm livestock and poultry;
- Freight on settlers livestock and effects when same are moved from an old holding to a new holding;
- Feed for wintering livestock and for work stock when clearing and/or breaking land;
- Moving settlers and their dependents to suitable land;
- Building, fencing and drainage materials and water pumps;
- Farm implements, machinery, parts and repairs, harness;
- Miscellaneous hardware including small tools;
- Clearing land including necessary explosives;
- Subsistence for settlers and their dependents assisted during the term of and pursuant to this agreement;
- Seed grain.

Section 2

The cost of the following items will not be contributed to by the Dominion pursuant to the terms of the attached agreement:-

- Administration expenses;
- Cost of lands;
- Wages for labour in erecting buildings and fences, in digging or laying individual farm drains and in digging wells, other than the wages of foremen carpenters and foremen masons.
