has been paid. Consequently a patent  
covering the land cannot issue to Mr  
McLean until there is some evidence  
produced to show that the money has  
been paid. If Mr. McLean holds any  
receipts for payments made in account  
of the lots he should produce them  
2<sup>nd</sup> The lot claimed by Mr. Nicholas  
having been paid for in full, a Patent  
therefor, in his favor, will be put in  
course of preparation forthwith.
