Sir,-

In reply to your letter No.4541 of the 28th ult. asking for authority to appoint two councillors for the Long Sault band No.2 and one for the Little Forke band, I beg to say that authority is hereby granted provided the vacancies exist; but according to the Department's record Long Sault band No.2 still has two councillors, namely, Attawayweninie, No.3, and Vapacomiciskung, No.12. If these two councillors have died, apparently you failed to advise the Department in special letters at the time.
