Sir,-

The Principal of the Blood Roman Catholic Boarding School states that his school was supplied with 1,207 lbs. of beef during the months of December, January, February and March last, and that his books, compared with the issuer's books, show this quantity to be correct.

The monthly beef statement furnished by you shows that the following quantities of beef were delivered to this school during each of the above named months, namely, December 400 lbs., January 475 lbs., February 170 lbs. and March 362 lbs., a total of 1,407 lbs. The sum of \$140.70 has been deducted from the March quarter grant to the school for that quantity of beef.

If the principal is correct that he only received 1,207 lbs. you should explain the difference in the statement furnished by you.

The principal is being requested to take this matter up with the issuer and have it adjusted.
