Sir,--

I have to acknowledge the receipt of a requisition for supplies for the Samson's Day School, and in reply I beg to say that the lead pencils, numeral frame, plasticine, scribblers, and ink powder will be ordered from the Government Stationery Office to be forwarded to the teacher's address.

You may purchase two dozen slates, three dozen hooks for hanging the children's clothes on, one broom, one door mat, forty-eight screws for fastening the desks to the floor, a lock and key for the door of the school and one scrubbing brush. Kindly forward detailed accounts, in duplicate, properly certified, for the expenditure incurred in the purchase of these supplies.
