- (2) In all of this section except subsections one and two thereof, "Director" includes any person whom the Director empowers to conduct an investigation under this section.
- (3) All provisions of the Inquiries Act not repugnant to the provisions of this section shall apply to an investigation under this section and the Director shall, for the purposes of this section, have all the powers of a Commissioner appointed under the Inquiries Act except in so far as such powers are inconsistent with this section.
- the Director may, at any time, in the course of an investigation under this section, by notice in writing, require any person, and in the case of a corporation any officer of such corporation, to make and render unto the Director, within a time stated in such notice, or from time to time, a written return under oath or affirmation showing in detail such information as is, by the notice, required, and such person or officer shall make and render unto the Director, precisely as required, a written return under oath or affirmation showing in detail the information required.
- (5) The Director, or any person thereunto authorized by him, may, for the purpose of an investigation under this section, enter any premises and exemine such premises and any books, papers, records or things in such premises.
- mises, books, papers, records or things shall give and afford to the Director or any person representing the Director admission or access thereto whenever and as often as demanded for the purpose of an investigation under this section, and if he fails to do so the Director or a person representing him may use such force as he deems reconnably necessary in the circumstances to obtain such admission or access.
- (7) The Director may, for the purpose of an investigation under this section, order that any person resident or present in Canada be examined upon oath before, or make production of books, papers, records or things to, the Director or before or to any person named for the purpose by the Director's
