

The timber limit or berth covered by this Licence No. 288 comprises the following lands:—

Mamalilikulla Indian Reserve #1 on the Western end of Village Island, Elliott Passage including three small Islands off shore at the entrance to Knight Inlet, Coast District, B.C., having a combined area of 434.25 acres.

~~Royalties payable:—~~

- (a) \$1 per thousand feet board measure on all timber suitable for saw-logs, boom-sticks, etc., scaled under the British Columbia log rule.
- (b) 75 cents per cord of 128 cubic feet on all timber suitable for shingle bolts, pulp-wood, cordwood or other woods customarily measured by the cord.
- (c) 2 cents per lineal foot on all timber suitable for piling, poles and spars.
- (d) 5 cents per tie and 3 cents per post.

Stumpage payable:— Including Royalty

merchantable timber, all species	\$3.75 per M.
Fuel logs	2.00 " "
