Continuance of the powers, granted by these Acts.

nor, Lieutenant Governor or person administering the Government of this Province for the time being, respecting the appointment and removal of the said commissioners and their Treasurer, as also all and every of the powers of the commissioners and their Treasurer, so appointed or to be appointed which are in them vested, by the acts or any of the acts above mentioned, is, and are hereby further continued, and shall remain in full force and effect for and during the space of two years from and after the second day of October next and no longer.

## CAP. IX.

ATHEREAS an Act was paffed in the forty-second year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, . An Act to provide for the more effectual regulation of the Police within the Cities of Quebec and Montreal and the Town of Three Rivers. also for extending regulations of Police to the Towns and Villages in certain cases and " for repealing the Acts or Ordinances therein mentioned;" which act was continued and amended by an act passed in the fifty-first year of His Majesty's Raign, intituled. . An All to continue in force the feveral Laws empowering the Justices of the Peace to " makerules and regulations of Police within the Cities of Quebec and Montreal and " the Town of Three Rivers and also rules and regulations for the Government of 4 Apprentices and others; and for extending regulations of Police to other Towns and " Villages in certain cases;" And which amends one of the said acts, which act above recited, passed in the forty-second year of His Majesty's Reign will expire on the first day of March of this year.
