About the time of the American Revolution this torture platform was removed and the open space added to the Alameda, resulting in a tract containing some twenty-two acres, being nearly 1,500 feet long and about half as wide. Miles of walks wind in and out among the shady nooks and pass in their meanderings a garden for birds and playgrounds for children, as well as numerous statues and figures.
