Vesses bound Northward by keeping this Light open with he North-head of Catair.a until Bonavista Light opens with Cape Le Jean, wi give the Fowers Rocks an ample berth-or when coming from the Northward and cound for Catalina, by giving the N. Head a moderate berth, you will clear the Brandies Rocks by steering for Green Island Light. Green Island is situated in 1st. 48. 30. N.
