GERMANY'S MOROCCO POLICY

Berlin, Nov. 5.—Political feeling will run high in the final session of the Reichstag and the debates promise to be stormy and rancorous. A number of important bills are awaiting cabinet but public attention will be concentrated upon the purely political aspect of the session so far as it may affect the forthcoming general elections and above all upon the interpellation debate. It is generally certain that several of the Parliamentary factions will ask the government to give an explanation of its Moroccan policy. Whether or not the Government finds it expedient to reply it cannot prevent a debate on the subject.

Smallpox in Quebec

Montreal, Nov. 6.—In spite of the measures adopted by the provincial board of health, smallpox is spreading in the province and is almost epidemic in some localities. The outbreak, which had been anticipated, is rather active in the Lake St. John district, the north shore, Beauce county, Joliet county, Ottawa district, and St. Maurice county. In the latter twenty cases have been recorded in one municipality since beginning of November and the strictest measures have been adopted.

Ottawa, Nov. 6.—The dismissal of thirty fishery inspectors in Ontario by the Federal Government is stated today by Marine Department officials to mean that the work of these overseers will hereafter be performed by provincial officers. Ontario has for long time desired this change.

EXPECT DEFEAT FOR ITALIANS AT TRIPOLI

If Turks and Allies Win There Will Be Terrible Massacre—Indignation is Rising in England—Turkish Ambassador at London Denies Reports of Cruelty.

London, Nov. 6.—Wireless messages received from Tripoli state that the Turks and Arabs are ready to attack Tripoli and that a crushing defeat for the Italians seems inevitable. The messages state the attack was expected hourly. If the Turks and their Arab allies are victorious, it is believed one of the most terrible massacres in history will be the result. Dispatches reporting atrocities are coming in from all points. English, French and German correspondents tell the same story of Italian barbarism and pictures from their bearers tell these statements. Several of the pictures received today showed great piles of human and children murdered and mutilated.

English indignation at the butchery has reached a high pitch. Premier Asquith and Sir Edward Grey, the foreign secretary, are severely criticized for "prohibiting" a discussion of the massacres in parliament and the Tripoli consularly with the declaration of neutrality.

Not Freed from Responsibility.

"We have declared our neutrality as far as warlike preparations are concerned," answered the Daily Standard. "But our declaration does not free us of our responsibility. When the war is over and Italy proceeds to regularize her achievements, she will have to ask our consent to the denunciation of the Treaty of Paris by which she with ourselves guaranteed the integrity of the Ottoman empire. That consent need not be given unconditionally and the foreign office might hint that it would be withheld if the war were not conducted according to the recognized rules and usages of humanity."

Denies Allegations.

The Turkish ambassador at London denies the allegations of Italian correspondents of the Roman papers. "It is obvious," he says, "that the surrender of arms could only have been carried on by force and that the Arabs who could not have been submitted to the rule of the invaders were in their natural right to take up all the arms available to defend their territory."

Petersons today from Alexandria and Cairo said that Egypt was in a state of unrest and there was a rising sentiment in favor of sending large expeditions to Tripoli to aid the Turks. There have been several riots among the students at Alexandria who have adopted as their cry, "Long live the Sultan, death to the Italians."
