German Political Parties Favor Ultimatum Acceptance.

Stewards National Union Warn Members--Fracas Between the French and Germans--British Coal Strike Becomes More Alarming.

GERMANY YIELDING. BERLIN, May 9. The Majority Socialists and Clericals in party conferences to-day, voted to accept the ultimatum of the Allies.

FRENCH FIRE ON GERMANS. OPPELN, Upper Silesia, May 9. French soldiers to-day shot into a crowd of Germans who were threatening a Polish prisoner, killing two and wounding several others.

SHIPPING THREATENED. LONDON, May 9. The lockout of sea-going stewards and cooks, which was begun on May 6th, by the Shipping Companies, because of the men's refusal to accept a wage cut of about 17 per cent, took a serious turn to-day, when a manifesto was issued by the National Union of Ship Stewards and Cooks, declaring that officers of the owners on the old rate of pay in order to get ships away must not be accepted.

CANADA'S BUDGET. OTTAWA, May 9. Faced with the necessity of raising another sixty-two million dollars of revenue, Sir Henry Drayton, Minister of Finance, to-night, laid his taxation proposals before the House of Commons. His Budget has some sweeping additions in taxation, although not so general, perhaps, as many had expected.

SUPREME COUNCIL AND SILESIA. PARIS, May 9. With the object of showing that it will not be influenced by an action of the population of Upper Silesia, the Council of Ambassadors to-day, decided to request the Polish agitators, and to remind the German Government that until the decision of the Supreme Council with regard to the Plebiscite is announced, the Supreme Council retains full authority over the region, and to request the German Government consequently to abstain from all intervention.

DOUBTFUL COPENHAGEN, May 9. The British Government, a Russian source asserts, has given De Facto recognition to the Russian Soviet Government. No confirmation from any other source has been received.

FRENCH CROSS THE RUHR. BERLIN, May 9. A despatch to the Deutsche Allgemeine Zeitung from Muelheim to-day, says French troops crossed the Ruhr last night and occupied various points in the town of Muelheim, including the National Bank.

LOYD GEORGE AND SILESIA. LONDON, May 9. Lloyd George in the House this afternoon, referring to the Upper Silesia situation said that, while he might not be prepared to agree with the contention that Germany's answer on reparations matters would be influenced by the Silesian trouble, it was very unfortunate that this incident should have arisen at this moment.
