#### Norse Legend Attacked.

LAND-MARK NOT MARKLAND.

HALIFAX, N.S.-Moses H. Nickerson, Commissioner of Fisheries for Nova Scotia, takes a tilt at the legend that Norsemen in the eleventh or twelfth century gave Nova Scotia the wooded country. Mr. Nickerson was master of seven or more languages, that the word mark in the name Markland, because it was a note a forest.
