FRUIT SEASON IS ON IN EARNEST

Large Quantities Offered on the Market—Much Garden Produce—The Oat Crop.

The fruit season has opened in earnest. The various dealers on the market this morning had large stocks of peaches and plums and they found a ready demand although none of the fruit was of a particularly luscious or healthy variety.

The peaches, of course, were not the most desired free-stones. The "flawed" variety will not be marketed for a week or ten days, and even then the bulk of the fruit will not be brought in. Fruit is a little later this season than last, the dealers say, but judging from the reports the farmers bring in, it will be a large one and of good quality. There were several varieties offered and on account of the picking season being at hand very few of the hardier sorts were offered. The best of the peaches went as high as 65 cents for a dozen, and the poorest went as low as 25 cents. The same was the case with plums. The best went at about 45 cents and the lowest price received was 40 cents. Only a few baskets of pears were offered and they went at from 25 to 40 cents.

Large quantities of tomatoes were offered and on account of the picking season being at hand very few of the hardier sorts were offered. The best of the tomatoes went at 50 cents for a dozen, and the poorest went at 25 cents. The same was the case with plums. The best went at about 45 cents and the lowest price received was 40 cents. Only a few baskets of pears were offered and they went at from 25 to 40 cents.

There was an endless amount of garden produce, and a few thimbleberries which sold at 3 and 10 cents a box. With the farmers the talk was principally about the oat crop—just the same as last Saturday. The reports brought in tended to show that a great deal of damage had been done to the crop by the rains of the last week. It was a problem with the farmers toward the beginning of the week whether or not to bring the crops in the barn. They were becoming uneasy. Although the grain was damp, they feared that it would rain again and that the situation would be made worse. Consequently a great many brought the crops in and their oats will be of an inferior quality, but their cause in most cases the sheaves were soaked through.

Barley is reported to be the best crop in years. There is a large quantity of this grain grown around London, and never in many years have the prospects been so bright for a monster yield of the best quality. The grain as it can be seen now is healthy and the stalks are strong.

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TRAPPED AN EAGLE WITH HER SKIRTS

Big But Foolish Bird Tried to Carry Off Mrs. Shaw—Now He Is Caged.

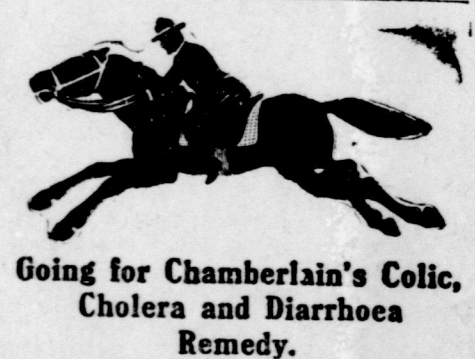
New York, Aug. 27.—A glorious American eagle, as jaunty as any that ever spread across a gold piece, got tangled ingloriously in a woman's petticoat yesterday afternoon. Now it is smothering out its ruffled feathers, no longer a bird of freedom, in a cage at Cadwallader Park, Trenton.

Mrs. George T. Shaw, of No. 749 Beatty street, Trenton, fought this eagle and vanquished it with her petticoat. It measured just five feet, eleven inches, from tip to tip, and it looks hungry.

Mrs. Shaw and her friend, Mrs. Arnot Penrose, of No. 321 Monmouth street, Trenton, were walking in Mrs. Penrose's garden yesterday when down swooped the eagle. The big bird sunk its talons into Mrs. Shaw's shoulders and actually tried to carry her off.

The women screamed for help. Mrs. Shaw threw herself to the ground, and the bird flattered away for a second. Before she could arise it flew at her again, and gripping her skirt tried to rise with her. The terrifying spectacle of the ungainly bird smothering her with its ruffled wings did not deter Mrs. Shaw. She drew them up over the struggling bird, enveloping it. The eagle fought with its head and back, talons and wings.
