THE MONARCH FIRE INSURANCE COMPANY'S TENTH ANNUAL REPORT.
The Monarch Fire Insurance Company's tenth annual report will be found on another page of this issue. The business for the year shows very satisfactory progress, the company having increased its cash assets for the protection of its 9,500 policyholders by \$8,522,94. Under the New Insurance Law as passed by the Legislature, it was necessary to place the reserves upon a much higher basis than heretofore. This has been complied with, and the reserves for the protection of the policyholders now amount to the sum of \$23,988,74.

The statement shows that all adjusted losses for the year 1912 have been paid in the usual prompt manner. The company having paid to date the sum of \$401,455 in claims to its various policyholders throughout the province. The surplus over all liabilities shown by the annual report including the Government Reserve is \$63,104.38, and the full protection for its policyholders including the company's subscribed capital now amounts to the sum of \$134,154.78. It is the only fire insurance company with head offices in London.

MRS. TRICK DEVOTED TO WORK OF MISSIONS

Estimable Lady Expires as Result of Pneumonia Developing From Cold.

The death of Mrs. Susan Trick, wife of Mr. Walter Trick, occurred on Tuesday afternoon at the family residence, 509 King street. Mrs. Trick contracted a severe cold a short time ago which developed into bronchial pneumonia, and resulted in her death.

Mrs. Trick was born at St. Giles-in-the-Wood, Devonshire, England, and came to this city twenty years ago, and had since resided here continuously.
Besides a sorrowing husband, she leaves two sons, William and John Trick, of Vancouver, B. C., one daughter, Mrs. Ernie Thorne, of this city, and a nephew and niece in England.
The funeral will be held at 2:30 o'clock on Thursday afternoon, and interment will be made at Woodland Cemetery.
Rev. Dr. Manning, pastor of Dundas Centre Methodist Church, will have charge of the funeral services, assisted by Rev. W. H. Boyd, of the Adelaide Street Baptist Church.
