British Columbia and Japan—A London cablegram says that the Japanese ambassador in London has recently been Mr. Chamberlain respecting the Anglo-Japanese Alliance, the Tokio Asiatic, following Mr. Chamberlain's forecast, as one of the principal promoters of the alliance, says that "this news goes somewhat to balance the unpleasant feeling caused by British Columbia anti-Japanese legislation."

A Telephone Trouble—Some time during Thursday evening a telephone person or persons maliciously incited out the B. C. Telephone Company's wires at two points, Goldstream and Shawinigan—thus interrupting communication. In an effort to apprehend the guilty parties, the company is offering a reward of \$100 for information that will lead to their arrest and conviction. It is expected that the new company will be capitalized for \$15,000,000 to \$20,000,000. It will be a close corporation, all the stocks taken by parties directly concerned in the merger.
