Minutes of the Presbytery of Barrie were read recommending that the salary of Rev. Allan Find-lay, Superintendent of Missions in the Muskoka district, should be increased from \$1,200 to \$1,600 per annum, with travelling expenses. It was decided to refer the latter to the full meeting of the Committee in Maich, with a recommendation in its favour.

favour.

Rev. Dr. Robertson gave an interesting report on his visit to certain districts in British Columbia, speaking particularly of the great spiritual destitution in many parts of that field, arging upon the Committee the necessity of sending more labourers at as early a date as possible.

Rev. Dr. Warden and Rev. D. J. Macdonnell reported verbally as to their recent visit to Prince Albert, undertaken in accordance with instructions from the General Assembly. A formal report will

from the General Assembly. A formal report will be prepared at a future date. It was agreed to recommend that the salary of the minister at Prince Albert should be \$1,200, the Committee agreeing to pay of this sum not more than \$400.




