THE AMERICAN ELECTIONS.

Henry George Gets Badly Routed—Democrats Gain—The Results in New York and Other Cities.

NEW YORK, Nov. 8.—The State election to-day resulted, so far as can be told at present writing, in the election of the Democratic State ticket, headed by Cook for Secretary of State, by about 10,000 or 15,000, though later returns may modify this estimate.

A CLOSE CONTEST AT BUFFALO.

BUFFALO, Nov. 8.—There is a very close contest for the majority. Philip Becker, seeking re-election, was opposed by ex-Mayor Solomon Schenck, who was previously defeated.

LATER—In Buffalo city for mayor 55 election districts out of 61 give Becker (Republican) 15,258, and Schenck (Democrat) 15,251. The count will not be completed to-night.

FELLOWS DEFEATS NICOLS FOR THE NEW YORK DISTRICT ATTORNEYSHIP.

NEW YORK, Nov. 8.—The State and all other contests in this city were of insignificant interest compared to the contest between Fellows and Nicols, the present assistant in the District Attorney's office, as to which should succeed District Attorney Martin.

MASSACHUSETTS.

BOSTON, Nov. 8.—The enormous crowds in the streets and in the corridors of hotels indicate that the interest in the state contest is very much greater than usual.

IN OTHER STATES.

BES MONIES, Ia., Nov. 8.—Meagre returns show a very light Democratic gain, but there will be no material change from last year.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa., Nov. 8.—The entire Republican state ticket is elected, but their principal municipal candidates were defeated in this city by small majorities.

CINCINNATI, Ohio, Nov. 8.—Forsaker (Rep.) is re-elected governor by an increased majority.

JACKSON, Miss., Nov. 8.—The election to-day in Mississippi for members of the Legislature and county officers was the quietest unknown. There will be few other than straight out Democrats in the next Legislature.

LINCOLN, Neb., Nov. 8.—It has been raining all day and a light vote was polled, with reduced Republican majority on the state ticket.

PORTLAND, Ore., Nov. 8.—A steady light rain fell all over the western section of the State to-day. The vote was light in the interior, all interest centering in prohibition.

DENVER, Nov. 8.—The municipal contest to-day resulted in the election of the entire Democratic ticket, with exception of the city treasurer, by majorities ranging from 1,800 to 3,000.

MONTEAL, Wednesday, Nov. 16, 1887. The various markets to-day have done a good business, especially in hay and grain, which has come in freely and in good quantities.

The stock of game is quite large this morning, implying that the boys put in a goods day's work Sunday. Harvest, potatoes, 55c, venison 11c to 15c, per pound. Fowls and turkeys remain at old prices.

There seems to be a little better feeling in the wheat market, especially for Manitoba wheat, which is eagerly sought for for home consumption.

The call for fresh eggs is equal to the demand, and 25 cents seems the ruling price. There is quite a stock in the market that have seen their best days, which can be bought at optional prices.

There was not a large quantity of butter offered yesterday, and prices for fall lots, "frost bitten," sold at 21c to 23c; summer lots way down. Cheese, none offered.

There were 23,000 hogs received at the market Tuesday, while 32,000 were expected; hence prices were firm at sight advance.

At the V. Oxford, Ontario, cheese factory there may be seen five monster cheeses, aggregating in weight 22,000 pounds, a sight which, we believe, has never before been seen.

The local market was well attended, but not so full of interest as of late. A large load of cattle were forwarded, the quality most excellent.

The butter market for the past two or three days has been exceedingly tranquil and sales have been slow.

The market continues to be well supplied, and choice fruit is in demand, but the prices are too stiff to warrant any large sales.

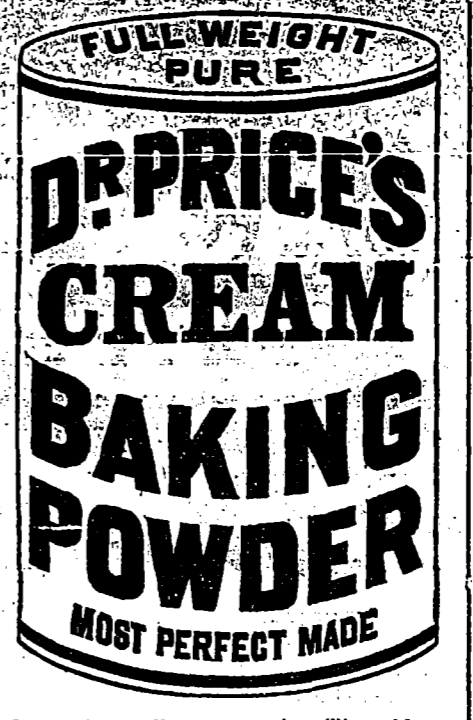

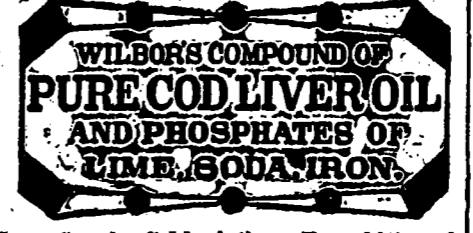
