GRANTS UNDER OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH PROGRAM

Question No. 1,449—Mr. Mazankowski:

- 1. How many grants have been made to date under the Opportunities for Youth Program?
- 2. What is the name and province of residence of each successful applicant?
- 3. What amount (a) was requested (b) was granted?
- 4. What grants are presently under consideration?
- 5. What is the name and province of residence of the applicants?
- 6. What amount is being considered and when will the grant be awarded?
- 7. How is the initial payment to be made to the successful applicant?

Hon. Gérard Pelletier (Secretary of State): 1. Opportunities for Youth had made approximately 2,304 grants as of May 31st.

- 2. A report is being prepared for public release containing the names of the successful applicants. Approved projects, by province, have been announced in periodic press releases.
- 3. At best, the total amount requested was awarded. However, many amounts requested were adjusted in accordance with Opportunities for Youth criteria and the relative funds available. (a) The target was set at \$1,000 salary per student, per summer (i.e. for a three month period). (b) Minimum overhead costs were funded where absolutely necessary.
- 4. It is impossible to retrace the exact number of grants that were under consideration as of May 19th, but by May 31st 2,304 grants had been awarded.

 - 6. No applicable.
- 7. Each successful applicant received a contract outlining the terms of agreement under which he would carry out his project. After he had signed the contract and returned it to Opportunities for Youth he received a photocopy of the contract now bearing the signature of the Secretary of State, Under Secretary of State or Assistant Under Secretary of State. The first payment, a percentage of the whole amount, was then forwarded to him either from the Opportunities for Youth office or directly from the M.P. of his riding.
