- (9.) Any motion or resolution offered for the consideration of the Instit of 'hall, at the request of any member, be reduced to writing before it can be acted upon.
- (10.) Discussion on religious or political subjects shall not be permitted at any of the meetings of the Institutc.

YIV.

ON AMENDING THE BY-LAWS.

- (1.) These By-laws may be amended at any meeting of the Institute; provided due notice of the proposed amendment shall have been given at the regular meeting of the Institute previous to that at which the amendment is to be voted upon; and the said amendment, if carried, shall take effect immediately.
- (2.) Provided that no amendment be voted upon unless there be at least twelve Fellows present.
