

Here follows what is called the CANON OF THE MASS, which includes the CONSECRATION and ELEVATION of the HOST, after which the Priest says :--

Priest.--World without end.

Choir.--Amen.

Priest.--Let us pray. Admonished by Thy saving precepts, and following Thy divine institution, we presume to say :

Panem earth as it is in heaven. Give us nostrum quotidianum da nobis this day our daily bread; and for hodie: et dimitte nobis debita give us our trespasses, as we forgive nostra, sicut et nos dimittimus those who trespass against us, debitoribus nostris. Et ne nos And lead us not into temptation, inducas in tentationem.

Choir.--Sed libera nos a malo.

Choir.--But deliver us from evil.
