In the evening the ice opened more than was usual and we had a good run until near midnight, when we made fast. During the evening we saw a very larg bear lying on a piece of ice, a-head of us. Two boat were instantly sent in chase of him, and had approached very close before he moved, when, appearing a scent them, he quietly took to the water. It was with great difficulty he was killed, and he boldly turned to face his pursuers as long as he had sufficient strength for he swam rapidly, and could make long springs in the water. As these animals, although very fat as bulky, sink the instant they die, he was lashed to beat, and brought alongoide. On hoisting him in were astonished to find that his weight exceeds 1600lbs!
