Pastor Russell's Sermon Text: "The Earth Shall Be Full of the Knowledge of the Lord, as the Waters Cover the Sea."—(Isaiah ii, 9).

S. S. Mauretiana, Mid-Ocean, May 9.—Pastor Charles T. Russell on board in an excellent mood, but joy cometh in the morning. The millennial morning. Assuredly our text has never yet had a fulfillment, but just as surely it shall be fulfilled, for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken; yea, more, hath declared that ultimately "every knee shall bow and every tongue confess Messiah, to the glory of God the Father." Some time ago in our Sunday school hymnals a very popular melody was entitled "Showers of Blessings" and prayed, "Let some droppings fall upon me." This truly expresses the Christian's experience in the present time. The Lord permits his people to have sunshine, clouds and showers for their refreshment, for their development. Nevertheless the showers of refreshment never seem to come with sufficient frequency, and we continually rejoice in the hope that "still there's more to follow." What a contrast, therefore, is suggested by the words "The Earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea." How will it come to pass? Are the incredulous enquiries, it seems too good to be true that, after a reign of sin and death lasting for thousands of years, so wonderful a change is to be brought about? The Scriptures answer our query, and explain the reason, stating that the world's conversion comes not by might nor by power of man, but "by my spirit, saith the Lord." The Holy Spirit will also then be poured out upon His servants and upon His handmaids, and upon them will be the end of this age and the dawning of the new dispensation the Lord will pour out His spirit upon all flesh. "I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh." But what will be the cause of this change in the Divine order? The answer is, "The righteousness of the old and foretold thru the prophets?" Evidently it is not a change of the Divine purpose or intent, but merely a change in the Divine operation, for "known unto the Lord are all the thoughts of the world." A lesson we all need to learn is that as, in human operations, time and order are observed, and we are disposed to resent the thought arrangement in the construction a foundation is first requisite, and the order of the elements in the building touches mark the completion of the edifice. So in the Divine purpose and not until the finishing touches shall be put on the edifice, will the church, the architect and builder of creation's wonderful temple be manifested. We are at present in the formative period of which He prophesied of old. Messiah has come, has died for the sins of men, has arisen from the dead, has ascended into heaven, and has seated Himself on the throne of glory. The church, spiritual Israel, gathered from natural Israel and from all the families of the earth, is being prepared for their process of selection for nearly nineteen centuries. Soon it will be completed—the predestined number possessing this "covenant of grace" will have been found and tested and developed and polished and fitted and prepared for the additional sacrifices, which they have been called as Messiah's bride and joint-heir in His kingdom. Then the King and Queen of the Millennium shall appear on God's part to give work, a great change in the Divine program of earth will take place.

The Scriptures most distinctly teach that we are under the reign of the "Prince of this world," Satan, and that he is the author of all our iniquities in power and great glory will bind or restrain this strong one and overthrow His empire, which is not of Divine authority, but built on the weakness, ignorance and superstition. We are distinctly told that Satan shall be bound for that thousand years (the millennium) and that he will deceive the people no more until the thousand years shall be finished.
