With pleasure we remember the visits to our schools of members of your family, the recollection of which is a joy in the chain which so completely binds a willing people to Your Majesty, and it was with a glad heart that we witnessed the departure from our midst of Her Royal Highness the Princess Louise, who, during her sojourn amongst us, in every way endeared herself to our people and brought us measurably nearer to the person of Your Majesty.
