Helsingfors, Finland, Dec. 16.—A petition signed by a majority of the members of the Finnish diet has been presented to the presidents of the diet, protesting against numerous edicts and measures, such as the introduction of the Russian language in government offices, the dismissal of Finnish functionaries, the new constription law, etc., which have been enforced contrary to law and without the co-operation of the diet, and which have created a condition of affairs resembling a state of siege, and urging that the diet should, at the soonest possible day, bring forward measures for the re-establishment of legal administration and the restoration of elegal order.
