The frost which prevailed during the end of last month will continue until the 6th of this. On the 7th snow will fall. On the 9th a thaw, succeeded by temperate weather until the 12th, when a frost will again set in. On the 15th, dark, cloudy and cold weather, threatening snow, until the 13th, when it will again become clear and frosty. On the 22d a heavy fall of snow succeeded by clear weather,—on the 27th more snow,—on the 29th clear again, with good sleighing.

Blackberries are extremely useful in cases of dysentery. To eat the berries is very healthy. Tea made of the roots and leaves is beneficial; and a syrup made of the berries, is still better. Blackberries have sometimes effected a cure when physicians have failed.
