Digging Grave; Find Skeleton

Body Placed Downward in Crumpled Position

Brighton, Ont., May 17.—While excavating a grave for a \$5,000 cow that died on the farm of C. Baker, near here, a human skeleton was unearthed. Part of a shoe was also discovered, leading to the belief that the body was clothed when buried. The position of the body, placed downwards in a crumpled position, and the shallow excavation made, led to the impression that the body had been buried hastily. Coroner Dr. F. M. Dure, of Brighton, has taken charge of the skeleton, which will be sent to Toronto for expert examination.

Reds Plan to Send Envoys to Labor Parley in Sydney

Communists Make Little Headway in Australia in Agitation for Support of Radical Policies.

London, April 15.—(By mail.)—It is reported here that according to a Moscow message the Third Internationale intends to send delegates to a congress of Communists in Sydney, writes the Melbourne correspondent of The London Times.

In a recent issue of The Times a Telegram from its Flga correspondent gave the import of the Moscow message referred to above in the following terms:

"It is reported that the Australian Communist party is arranging for a conference at Sydney of Communists from all parts of the Pacific and that the Third Internationale is sending three delegates, who will probably be headed by Radek."

For some time past the extremist strong in Australian Labor circles have attempted to spread Red propaganda among the executives of the large unions, but there are clear indications that the workers themselves are disinclined to accept such doctrines. The Congress of the Australian Labor Parties, held at Brisbane last year, adopted several resolutions of a strongly Communist character, and the Congress of Trades Unions in July last year reaffirmed its intention of obtaining the "socialization" of industry by means of the workers "uniting in one class-conscious organization to take and hold the means of production by revolutionary industrial and political action."
