TESTIFIES WIFE THREW DINNER SET AT HIM Teacher, in Separation Suit, Says He Was Kept Busy Dodging Missiles. White Plains, N. Y., Sept. 30.—In the trial of the separation suit brought by Mrs. Elizabeth J. McLuckie against her husband, John McLuckie, a New York school teacher, on the charge of cruelty and abandonment, McLuckie, appearing before Supreme Court Justice J. Addison Young, told how he had thrown the hardwares of chinaware aimed by his wife.

"I think it was on March 27 last," said McLuckie, "that my wife threw an entire set of chinaware that was on the dining room table at my head. It kept me busy dodging the plates and cups and other pieces of crockery."

On another occasion he said his wife asked him for some money and when he gave her \$2, all he had in his pocket, she started to hurl all the decorations on her bureau at him. He said they had many quarrels.

"She started so quickly I can't tell you, judge, what happened, everything moved so fast."

After all the testimony was in, Justice Young said that he believed that the best thing to do was to withhold his decision for six months and that the defendant pay his wife \$20 weekly in the meantime to see if they could reach some agreement.

"Were you in fear of her?" he was asked.
