### NO NEED TO DIE OF DIPHTHERIA

(Toronto Globe)

Diphtheria is a disease which no one should die, Dr. John Fitzgerald, Director of the Connaught Anti-toxin Laboratory, declared in the course of an address on the work of the institution, delivered before the members of the Young Men's Club of the Toronto Board of Trade last night. He pointed out that about 80 per cent. of adults never get diphtheria, because they have a little anti-toxin in their blood, though how they get it was not known.

The Schick test enabled persons to ascertain if they were immune from the disease, and if it were found that they were susceptible to it, they could be treated with anti-toxin. It was possible absolutely to prevent diphtheria in children by finding out by means of the Schick test whether they were susceptible, and if they were they could be given the anti-toxin. This was the effective for at least five years, and in many cases for life.

Dr. Fitzgerald pointed out that until the establishment of the Connaught Anti-toxin Laboratory, there was nothing of the sort in Canada, and between \$120,000 and \$180,000 used to go out of the Dominion to obtain the anti-toxin, and the people who needed them most were unable to get them. Referring to the foundation of the laboratory in 1913, he made mention of the fact that the institution was run by a university. A year after this laboratory was started it was sending out anti-toxin and vaccines to every province in the Dominion, as well as to Newfoundland, and even to New Zealand. It was the only institution of its kind in the Dominion, and one of five in the British Empire.

The speaker gave an interesting account of the way in which horses are treated for the production of anti-toxin, and gave a number of lantern views describing the Connaught Laboratory and other matters. He said that at the laboratory they also produced lockjaw serum, smallpox vaccine, and meningitis serum.

Replying to a member, Dr. Fitzgerald said the amount of suffering caused to the horses treated was very slight.
