Schick test whether they were susceptible, and if they were they could be given the anti-toxin. This was the effective for at least five years, and in many cases for life.

Dr. Fitsgerald pointed out that until the establishment of the Connaught Anti-toxin Laboratory, there was nothing of the sort in Canada, and between \$120,000 and \$150,000 used to go out of the Dominion to obtain the anti-toxins, and the people who needed them most were unable to get them. Referring to the foundation of the laboratory in 1913, he made mention of the fact that the University had taken an interest in the matter from the outset, a fact which was University had taken an interest in the matter from the outset, a fact which was rather unique, as Berne, Switzerland, was the only other place where such an institution was run by a university. A year after this laboratory was started it was sending out anti-toxins and vaccines to every province in the Dominion, os well as to Newfoundland, and even to New Zealand. It was the only institution of its kind in the Dominion, and one of five in the British Empire. tion of its kind in the Dominion, and one of five in the British Empire.

The speaker gave an interesting account of the way in which horses are treated for the production of antitoxin, and gave a number of lantern views describing the Connaught Laboratory and other matters. He said that at the laboratory they also produced lockjaw serum, smallpox vaccine, and meningitis serum. Replying to a member, Dr. Fitzgerald said the amount of suffering caused to the horses treated was very slight.
