

## UNIQUE TYPEWRITER

A typewriter that will write syllables has just been invented by Paul de Casanville, a newspaper man of Brussels, Belgium.

Mr. de Casanville's machine has been used by a typewriter, for it would consider the syllables of a word as a unit. It is a machine with 100 keys, and 100 moving levers on its machine have exceeded 100 words a minute within three minutes.

Mr. de Casanville distributes his letters into groups, corresponding to the syllables of a word. The basis of each syllable is a vowel.

Mr. de Casanville has been worked out for the French language. For the English the same number of groups, eight, would be used. There would be only a few fewer letters, because there would be no need of duplication for each letter. The number of groups of letters might be changed. In either arrangement, the machine would be a unique one.

It could precede and follow a vowel in one syllable.

It could combine some other ingenious improvements. For example, it is that it automatically returns to the beginning of the next line, and if necessary places a hyphen when a word is divided by the end of a line.
