DIES ON SECOND ATTEMPT.

Port Chester Woman Who Took Poison in July Kills Herself With Gas.

Greenwich, Conn., Sept. 13.—A second attempt at suicide proved successful for Mrs. Elizabeth Adams, wife of George V. Adams of Port Chester, N. Y. Mrs. Adams drank four ounces of co-

dine on July 31 last, but regretted her action, and saved her own life by drinking a cupful of salt and water. While alone in her house on Saturday she became melancholy again over her illness. She attached a rubber hose to the gas fixture in her bedroom, locked the doors and windows, lay down on the bed and held the end of the tubing to her nose. She was found dead by her husband.

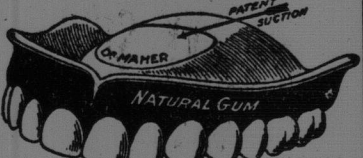
