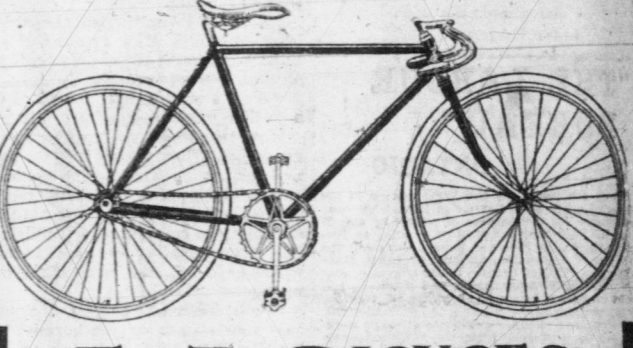
And yet our churches do some good. While I am not a supporter of any church, I am not an opponent of any. Whenever a church is erected the moral tone of the neighborhood is raised.
