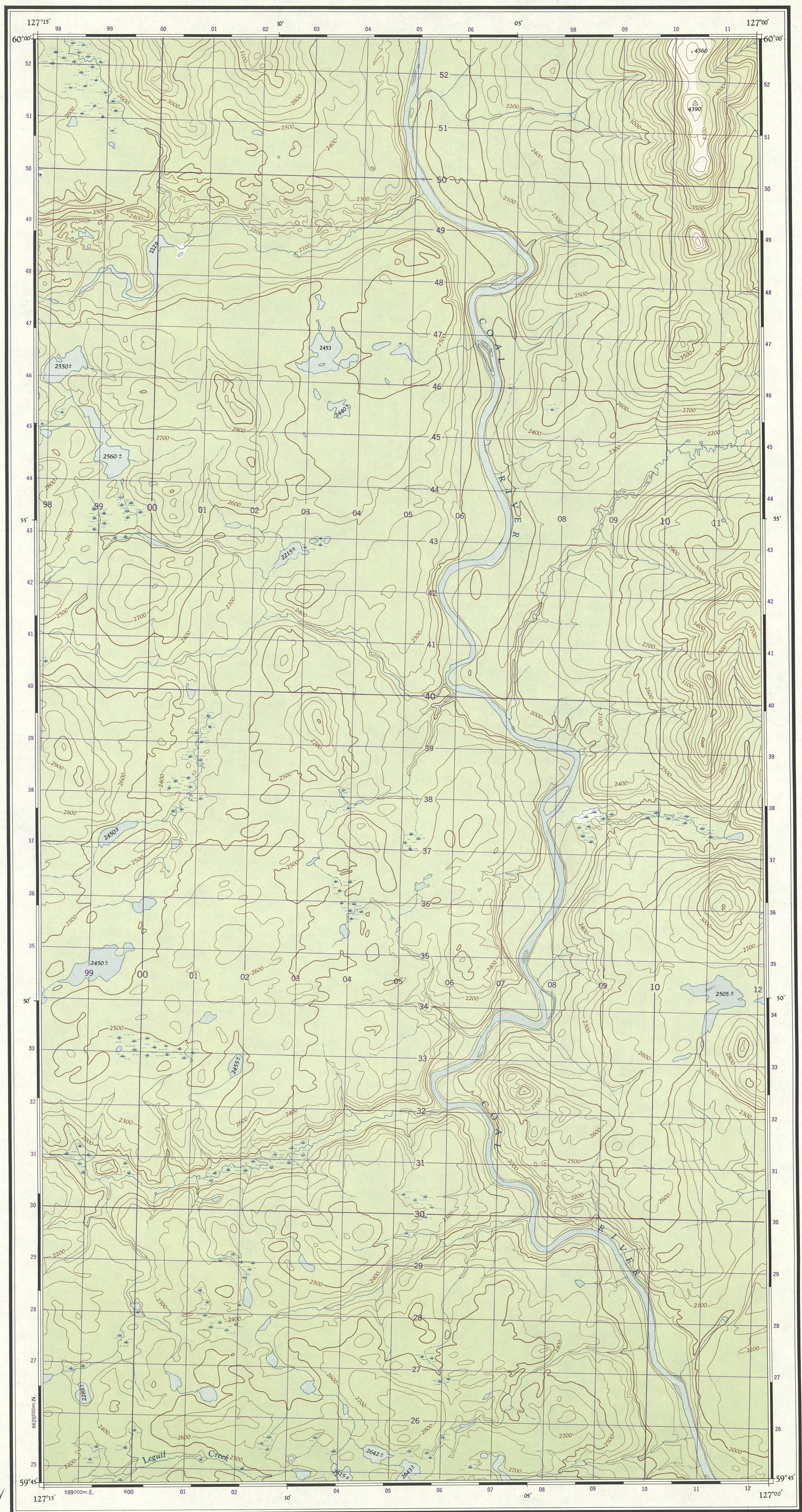

POINT STREAM JUNCTION

FOR STANDARD MILITARY GRID REFERENCE

East 050 North 356

Take West edge of square which contains point, and read the figure printed opposite this line on North or South margin or on the line itself on the face of the map. (Figure reads 050)

Take South edge of square which contains point, and read the figure printed opposite this line on East or West margin or on the line itself on the face of the map. (Figure reads 356)
