Dominion and the institutions and
ideals of our common county,"

We do most earnestly request that
the cities and municipalities of the

Sunday, the ist of July, do honor to
the memory of the noble and brave
men who have made the supreme sacrifice for their country, as well as to
those who are still facing danger and
death upon the battlefield, and that
the religious exercises of the day be
characterized with a spirit of loyalty,
unselfish service, and earnest prayer
for the success of the sacred cause for
which we are fighting.

Monday, the 2nd of July, all municipal

various patriotic localities, and that all
citizens by a display of flags and suitable decorations at their homes and
places of business, give hearty support
