

SINCLAIR, JOHN H. (*Guysboro'*).

Father, Donald Sinclair, a native of Caithness-shire, Scot., came to N.S. in 1815, and settled shortly afterwards at Gosben, Guysborough Co. Mother, Jane McNeill, was a native of Inverness-shire, Scot., and came to N.S. about 1820. B. at Gosben, 27 May, 1848, and ed. at the District School there, Guysborough Academy, and Dalhousie Coll., Halifax. Graduated LL.B. in Halifax Univ. M. at New Glasgow, 13 July, 1886, Jessie, dau. of J. W. Carmichael, ex M.P. for Pictou. Called to the Bar N.S. Was Mayor of New Glasgow in 1890 and 1891. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1894. A Liberal, and in favor of promoting railway extension, improvement of the public highways, encouragement of agriculture and the abolition of the Legislative Council.—*New Glasgow, N.S.*

TANNER, CHARLES ELLIOTT, Q.C. (*Pictou*).

Father, Richard Tanner, was a native of Brandon, Irel., and mother, Janet Brown, was a native of Dumfries, Scot. B. in Pictou, N.S., 7 Oct., 1857, and ed. at the Academy there. M., 15 Sept., 1886, Alicia May, dau. of Robert McDonald, Pictou. Called to the Bar of N.S. 1878, and apptd. Q.C., 1895. Was a mem. of the Town Council in 1886. Apptd. Stipendiary and Recorder of Pictou, 1888. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1894. A Conservative.—*Pictou, N.S.*

WALLACE, W. B. (*Halifax*).

Called to the Bar, N.S., 1884. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at by-election held 8 Aug., 1896, to fill vacancy caused by resignation of Hon. Mr. Fielding, who was elected to the Commons at g. e., 1896. A Liberal.—*Halifax*.

WICKWIRE, HARRY H. (*King's Co.*).

Of Loyalist stock—coming on father's side from Connecticut and on mother's from Pennsylvania. B. at Canning, N.S., 21 June, 1868. Graduated B. A. at Acadia Coll., 1888, and LL.B. at Dalhousie Coll., 1891. M., 27 June, 1895, Sarah J., dau. of J. J. Loyitt, Yarmouth, N.S. Called to the Bar, N.S. Has been Crown Attorney for King's Co. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1894. A Liberal.—*Kentville, N.S.*

WILCOX, CHARLES S. (*Hants*).

B. at Windsor, 21 Dec., 1852. Is a hardware merchant, and was Mayor of Windsor in 1894 and 1895.—*Windsor, N.S.*
