BILL.

An Act to increase the number of sittings of the Circuit Court at Richmond and Stanstead.

WHEREAS it is expedient, in order to meet the Preamble.
wants of the inhabitants of the District of Saint Francis, and to obviate protracted litigation, that the Circuit Court should be holden at Shipton and Stanstead, 5 in the said District, three times a year instead of twice a year as heretofore: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

That the Circuit Court shall hereafter be holden at the Village of Richmond, in the Township of Shipton, in and for the Circuit called the Richmond Circuit, from the 10 tenth to the nineteenth day, inclusively, of the months of January, May and September; and at Stanstead Plain, in the Township of Stanstead, in and for the Circuit called the Stanstead Circuit, from the tenth to the twentieth day of March; from the first to the tenth day of 15 July, and from the fifteenth to the twenty-fourth day of November, inclusively; instead of the times heretofore fixed by law for the holding of the said Court at the abovenamed places.

Times at which the Court shall be held at Richmond and Stanstead.
