An Act to Naturalize Anson Greene Phelps Dodge.

W HEREAS Anson Greene Phelps Dodge, residing at Keswick, Preamble. in the Township of North Gwillimbury, in the County of York, Province of Ontario, and Dominion of Canada, Lumber Merchant, has by his Petition represented that he is desirous of becoming a permanent resident of the said Dominion, and in order to be relieved from the legal incapacity under which he labors as an alien, has prayed that he may be naturalized as a subject of Her Most Gracious Majesty, and whereas it is just and expedient to grant such prayer: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons enacts as follows:

1. The said Anson Greene Phelps Dodge, shall be deemed, A.G.P. Dodgeadjudged, and taken to have obtained all the rights and to be deemed naturalized on capacities of a natural born British subject within the Dominion taking the of Canada, and to have, hold, possess, and enjoy the same oath of within the limits thereof, upon, from, and after the passing of within a this Act; provided always that the said Anson Greene Phelps certain time; Dodge, shall within three months after the passing of this Act, take and subscribe before the Judge of the County of York, who is hereby authorized and directed to administer the same, the oath of allegiance to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, and such oath as taken and subscribed shall be transmitted by such judge to the Secretary of State for Canada, to be kept by him amongst the records of his Office.
