

the Parliament House or at any Committee, or in any of the rooms belonging to the Legislative Council, he shall appeal to the House for his reparation; which, if he shall not do, but occasion or entertain quarrels, declining the justice of the House, then the Member that shall be found therein offending, shall undergo the severe censure of the House.

XVIII.

That when a Question is under debate, no Motion shall be received in the House, unless to Amend it, Commit it, Postpone it to a certain day, or for the Order of the Day, or to Adjourn.

XIX.

That all Motions deemed Special, two days' notice thereof be given to the House, and any Motion (with leave of the House) may be withdrawn, any time before Amendment or decision.

Two day's notice of Special Motions required.
