

such Ship or Vessel from the Fisheries at the End of every Season, such Boat shall be laid up by the Owner or Owners thereof, in such Place or Places as shall be approved of by the principal Officer of His Majesty's Customs of the Port at which such Ship or Vessel shall arrive, and shall not be employed or made use of in any Way whatever but in the said Fisheries.

Apprentices whole Times may expire during a Voyage, to be considered as such till the End of the Voyage.

VII. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That in case the Time for which any Apprentice shall have been indentured to serve on Board any Ship or Vessel employed in the last-mentioned Fisheries, or either of them, shall expire during the Voyage of such Ship or Vessel, such Apprentice shall be accounted and considered, to all Intents and Purposes, as an Apprentice for the whole Voyage, and shall, on the Ship's or Vessel's Return from the said Fisheries, or either of them, be mustered accordingly.

No Person to be deemed a legal Apprentice, if bound posterior to the passing of this Act, unless a Subject of His Majesty.

VIII. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That no Person shall be deemed a legal Apprentice, within the Intent and Meaning of this present Act, or of the said recited Acts, or either of them, except such Apprentices who have become such previous to the passing of this Act, unless he shall be a Subject of His Majesty.
