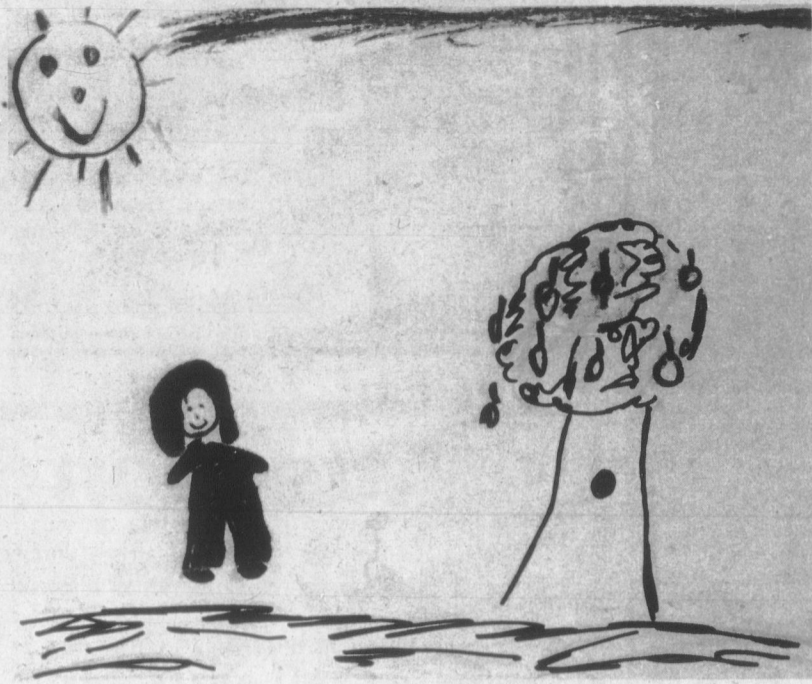


Kids turn on to poetry

But there's nothing else to do.

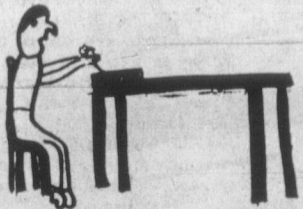


Billy Monhemius, 10, drew:
