Receipt is acknowledged of resolution of the Pasqua Band dated June 12, 1944, in which it is requested that \$1,500.00 be paid out of Band funds for the purpose of rebuilding fences and repairing and building reads on the Pasqua Reserve. It is noted that Mr. Christianson in his covering letter says that they are anxious to have one or two dams prepared this Fall and he asks that \$500.00 be forwarded.

The information supplied is rather sketchy, What fences are to be rebuild? Are they property of the Band as a whole or individuals? How much of the money is to be used in connection with fencing? What roads are to be built or repaired? Just how much money it is estimated will be necessary for repairing and just how much for building? Are the roads to serve the needs of individuals or are they roads to be used by the majority of the Band? If dam construction is being contemplated, where are they being built and for what purpose? How much will each cost? If Band funds are to be used for the dams mentioned a further resolution specifically covering them will necessarily accompany your report.

Further to hearing from you re the above points the request is in abeyance.
