As a Presbyterian I am strongly opposed to having my church taken from me. I have worked for a considerable time with the Presbyterian Church Association and from all the information that has been gathered, am certain that a majority of the members of the Presbyterian Church is opposed to Union. The Unionist leaders in the Presbyterian Church know this, and for this reason will not take another vote.
